1° week

- Introduction to the chronology problems of the site and its destruction by an earthquake 4000 years ago
- Problems of restoration and solutions applied to handmade pottery
- Cleaning and identification of fragments
- Assembling of items

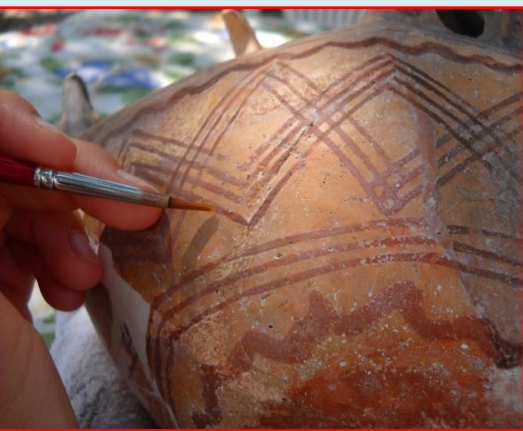
2° week
